Code of conduct 2018

This code applies to all matches deemed as a representative match where the scorer has been appointed by the QCSA.

All scorer members will:

- act with honesty and integrity
- remain impartial even if an affiliation exists to one of the teams
- treat all colleagues with respect, courtesy, honesty and fairness
- take all actions to ensure they are seen as positive role models
- maintain an appropriate standard of dress for representative fixtures by wearing the designated QCSA shirt (or other shirt issued for the match or series), long pants, dress shorts or skirt, closed casual shoes and the QCSA name badge
- maintain a professional workplace and work with their scoring partner in a courteous, positive and constructive manner at all times, ensuring teamwork is maintained firstly with each other and then with any other party, such as online scorers, media, team management and public
- not pass judgement regarding on-field decisions made by their umpiring colleagues, particularly where such comments can be heard by others
- remain at the match or venue with their scoring partner until all scoring responsibilities, including the finalisation of the computer result and the completion of every aspect of the score card, have been finished
- if an allocated senior scorer, check all score card information for accuracy and completeness before it is finalised
- not approach players, umpires, referees or dressing room attendants for personal mementos, including autographs or photos
- ensure that all procedures listed in the QCSA's *Essential procedures for representative scorers* are completed
- at all times act in the best interests of the QCSA and the game of cricket itself.
